Speakers Profile



Mr Greg Jakubowski

Mr. Greg Jakubowski is a fire protection engineer with more than 30 years of experience at facilities from small to very large. He has worked on project teams for almost US\$3 billion of projects in the US, England and Singapore and has worked with facilities in multiple countries to retrofit fire protection systems to existing unprotected facilities. Greg is a licensed Professional Engineer in Fire Protection in 3 States in the USA. He is a Certified Safety Professional (CSP), and was named by his peers as a Fellow in the Society of Fire Protection Engineers, USA. He has a B.S. in Fire Protection Engineering from the University of Maryland, and a M.S. in Public Safety from St. Joseph's University. His clients include: Ascend Performance Materials, Linde, Arkema Chemical, Merck (MSD), Glaxo SmithKline (GSK), Bristol-Myers Squibb (BMS), Capital Health Systems, and more. He has served in all roles from firefighter to fire chief in the fire services since 1978, teaches for several colleges/universities, and the US National Fire Academy.



Mr Ho Thim Seng

Mr. Ho Thim Seng is the chairman of Asian Institute of Intelligent Buildings (AIIB), Singapore chapter and a past president of the International Facilities Management Association (IFMA), Singapore chapter. Over the last 40 years, he managed and developed facilities for universities, commercial and residential buildings, and high-tech industrial park. He holds a Master of Science in Engineering and a Master of Business Administration from Brunel University in the UK. Regarded as an industry pioneer, he was member of the pioneer team that oversaw the creation of Singapore Management University. He was appointed as Director of the Estate & Facilities Management of Temasek Polytechnic (TP) to master plan and upgrade TP campus (2007–2015). He also served as a principal consultant for Babcock & Brown for Public- Private Partnership projects. Thim Seng is also a Green Mark Professional (GMP) that advocate for green buildings to drive the growth of green and smart buildings that leverage the ever expanding digital landscape. His bold idea is to establish data interoperability for building automation to support Singapore Smart Nation Initiatives.
